Manager Code of Conduct



1.0 Purpose:

The aim of this document is to ensure that all managers are aware of the minimum standards required following their selection as a manager within the SDBAL Junior Representative program.

2.0 Manager Commitment:

As a SDBA Junior Representative manager, I agree to:

- a. Abide by the SDBAL Zero Tolerance Policy (attached).
- b. Always conduct myself in a professional manner.
- c. Carry out my duties to the best of my ability.
- d. Attend any required SDBAL managers' meetings.
- e. Wear appropriate attire to all trainings and games.
- f. Assist with the development of a positive team culture where all players feel included and relevant.
- g. Ensure that any physical contact with a young person is appropriate to the situation and necessary.
- h. Treat other coaches, players, officials, parents, and spectators (including opponents) with respect.
- i. Establish open communication lines with parents and make myself available for discussions with parents at a suitable time for both parties if required.
- j. Attend all BQJBC games for my appointed team.
- k. Ensure that suitable parents are assigned to scoring each week via a score table roster.
- l. Be available to attend the appropriate Queensland State Championships for my appointed team.
- m. Comply with the SDBAL travel policy when attending Queensland State Championships.
